

Paper plate ring toss

(Fine motor skills, hand-eye coordination)



You will need:

- Paper plates
- Cardboard tubes (paper towel tubes)
- Paint
- Scissors
- Paint brushes
- Glue
- Anything else you would like to use to decorate your rings

To add a bit of challenge to your game, you can cut the cardboard tube into 3 different sizes (heights), or you can keep them all the same size.

To make your rings take a couple of paper plates and either paint them, draw on them with your kid or decorate them however you wish, (use glitter, buttons, feathers etc.).

Once your plates are ready and dry, cut the circles out of the middles.

To finish up just take a paper plate and glue the end of one of your cardboard tubes right in the middle. This will give your tube some balance and make it a lot easier to set up your game.

Model to your kid how to play that game and let the fun start by taking turns
