Geography Year3

<u>Locations and knowledge</u>	Know the names and Location of different countries (A European Country - Italy, Greece, Spain, France, Germany etc.)
<u>Place Knowledge</u>	Know about a region of the United Kingdom- Croydon
<u>Human and Physical geography</u>	Know what causes an Earth quake (link with science week) Label the different parts of a volcano (Link with science week)

Geography Year 4

Place and Knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A locality in a country that is less economically developed than the UK (Amazon Rainforests links with science animals and their habitats).
Human and physical geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• * Water and its effects on landscapes, people and animals.• Name and Locate a number of the world's largest river.• Know the features of a water cycle, Know the main features of a river.
Location knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Locate the world's countries, using Maps to focus on Europe and North and South America. (Linked with International Week).

Geography Year 5

Location and knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Know and locate the 7 continents• Know and locate the different countries in the UK
Place Knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Know about a region within North and South America (To be covered during international week).
Human and physical Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Know a physical or human feature from each country in the UK• Know which foods are grown locally and which are imported from overseas• Know types: of settlement and land use, economic activity including trade links, and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water (AFRICA)

Geography Year 6

<u>Location Knowledge</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Know the name of some countries, using maps to Focus on Europe (including the location of Russia) and North and South America.• Know the Names and locations of cities in the United Kingdom. (Compare UK and MEXICO)
<u>Place Knowledge</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Know the names and Locations of a seaside town.• Who, why people would visit a seaside town.
<u>Human and physical Geography</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Know features of a seaside town• Know natural and man made features of the seaside.
