Reporting Absence: Please remember that you can either report your child's absence via Weduc or you can leave a message on the telephone system. Please leave a specific reason for the absence so that we can mark it on the registers. We urge that rather than saying your child is 'unwell', you let us know the illness they have e.g. vomiting/diarrhoea/headache/cold etc so that we can add this to our absence records. Further, it is important that we know the illness your child has as we do have some vulnerable children in school that need to know if they have been in contact with illnesses such as Chicken Pox and Scarlet Fever.

GDPR form on Weduc: Please can you complete the GDPR form on Weduc. This is where you give permission for your child's photo to be used in school, on our school website and on social media. Please can you complete this as soon as possible. We are hoping to start making some training videos of strategies and resources we use in school and knowing which children we can use as part of these videos will be useful. We are only waiting for 50 more responses so if you are one of those 50, please make sure you complete the form.
